

Patricia Franceschetti was born in Neuchâtel (Switzerland) in 1964, lived and studied in Turin (Italy) until 1984, when she moved to London.

While working to earn her living and studying photography, she met and became the assistant to Romano Cagnoni.

She then begins to photograph different subjects on her own and continues to do so when she returns to Italy in 1986, publishing her photographic stories and articles in several magazines.

She holds solo exhibitions and participates in collective shows, she wins an award and she continues to work alongside Romano, who she marries in 2000.

Together they travel to the most turbulent places and publish stories together.

When she is home in Pietrasanta, she collaborates with various sculptors on their catalogues.

Romano Cagnoni disappears January the 30th 2018 and one and a half year later, she founds the Romano Cagnoni Foundation.
